## I. Minutes of the Meeting held on 25th January 2019

The minutes of the meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2019 had been circulated and were approved as a correct record. It was also agreed that the minutes could be published on the website.

## 2. Main Hall Floor - Update

Ivan Gosden reported that the repair work to the main hall floor has been finished. The invoices for the work total just over £13,000. Work is still required to ensure that there is enough ventilation to the main hall floor and professional advice will be sought. It was also agreed to check whether the chimney between the main hall and the garden room could be used for ventilation. It is hoped that the cost of the repairs will be covered by grant application.

Enquiries are being made regarding buffer hire to finish the new flooring. To hire a buffer would cost £40 plus £80 for delivery. The Caretaker is finding out whether a buffer can be hired from a local school. It was agreed to look into buying a buffer at some point.

- (b) ASTs for Cottages Bruce Batting reported that he has spoken to Wendy Smith at Simmons & Sons regarding ASTs for the cottages.
- (c) Staging Alan reported that staging similar to that used in Old Basing Village Hall would cost approximately £2,000. The staging is light and easy to move.

Action: Alan agreed to obtain more information on the staging for the next meeting

- (d) Bookings Ivan reported that Mole Valley have booked the village hall for their quarterly seminars
- (e) Wellington Arms Hotel Gilly agreed to contact Red Mist Leisure to see if they would be willing to give special rates to village hall bookings requiring accommodation.
